-  The Senior Adult Food Program, Commodity Supplemental Food Program is offered to senior adults age 60 and older, who meet the USDA Income Eligibility Guidelines.
-  Each month, CSFP participants receive a 25-30-pound box of shelf-stable groceries, valued at \$60-\$70, and a 2-pound block of commodity cheese to supplement their diets. Contents include canned fruits, vegetables, and animal proteins. There is also cereal and additional protein items like dry beans, peanut butter, grains, liquid milk, and dry milk on alternating months. Each item provided to CSFP clients is intended to be a healthy addition to meals they prepare at home when other food sources are running low.
-  Seniors who are homebound may assign a friend, family member, or care-taker to serve as a helper (called a proxy) to collect their food box on a monthly basis.

-  IHP benefits individuals age 55 and older and/or disabled with proof of Social Security Disability. They are expanding services to include people laid off work or furloughed due to COVID-19 and ask you to bring a state-issued photo ID.
