

Village of Lake Tanglewood Chief of Police

The Village of Lake Tanglewood is seeking a community-oriented peace officer to serve as its next Chief of Police. The Village of Lake Tanglewood is a gated, lakefront community of approximately 700 residents in Randall County, Texas and a Type A General Law Municipality. The Chief reports to the Mayor and Board of Aldermen and is expected to build a positive working relationship with LSIOT (the Village's Property Owners Association). The Chief of Police will establish and enforce departmental policies, procedures and regulations; manage part-time officers and hours; manage budget and develop a strong relationship with the community while upholding state laws and local ordinances. In addition to administrative responsibilities, the Chief of Police is also expected to patrol the Village periodically by car and/or boat.

Required Qualifications:

- Must hold an active peace officer's license
- Must be a High School graduate or its equivalent (GED)
- Must hold an active Texas Class "C" driver's license.
- Must hold a Marine Safety Enforcement Officer (MSEO) Certificate or be willing to obtain MSEO certification within the first ninety (90) days of employment.
- Must be a citizen of the United States
- Must be at least 21 years of age

Preferred Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in criminal justice, law enforcement, or a related field is preferred.
- A minimum of five years' experience in a senior or commanding officer's role is preferred.

The Chief of Police is a fulltime, exempt position. The starting salary for the position begins at \$60,000 and is commensurate with experience.
