FY2024 1st Quarter Performance Report

## **BACKGROUND**

As stipulated in the agreement between Panhandle Regional Planning Commission and the Commission on State Emergency Communications (CSEC), the Panhandle 9-1-1 Network must establish and accomplish certain goals and objectives. In order to check progress throughout the year, we are required to submit to CSEC a quarterly performance report that includes 9-1-1 call volumes, monitoring results, network outage reports, system testing, and the status of equipment replacement. The following items make up the key points of the FY24 Q1 performance report covering September, October, and November.

- There were 25,421 9-1-1 calls received from the 21 regional call centers of with 19,986 being wireless (78.6 percent).
- Staff monitored Public Service Answering Points (PSAPs) twelve times with no findings.
- PSAP staff and PRPC staff performed 1,547 Network test calls.
- There was one outage during this quarter.
- The region received 1,459 text messages during this period, with the vast majority as test texts.
- Replaced all of the region's 9-1-1 recorders and six sites' uninterruptable power supply (UPS) batteries.

**CPE Subcommittee Review** 

## **BACKGROUND**

The Panhandle Regional 9-1-1 Network will be replacing Customer Premise Equipment (CPE) in the upcoming months. The Regional 9-1-1 Network posted a request for proposals (RFP) and received 5 proposals from different vendors. A subcommittee of the Panhandle Regional 9-1-1 Network Advisory Committee was formed to review, score, and recommend an actionable item to the Advisory Committee. The scoring was done according to a metric outlined in the RFP.

The Subcommittee scored the vendors as follows:

Intrado Life & Safety Solutions Corporation: 77

Carbyne: 52

MicroAutomation: 48

Comtech: 42 AT&T: 41

Because of the diversity amongst the two highest-scoring solutions, the Subcommittee decided to bring a recommendation to the board to negotiate with the two highest-scoring vendors to ensure certain functionality and cost provisions align with the needs of the Panhandle Regional 9-1-1 Network, PSAPs, and the citizens of the region.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends that the 9-1-1 Advisory Committee allow the Panhandle Regional 9-1-1 Network to enter into negotiations with the two highest-scoring vendors Intrado Life & Safety Solutions Corporation and Carbyne to replace the 9-1-1 CPE for the region.

Mapping Updates

### **BACKGROUND:**

The Panhandle Regional 9-1-1 Network's Mapping Department has been focusing on improving the 9-1-1 answering equipment maps. To date, we have added over 3,100 searchable rooms to the 9-1-1 map in addition to the thousands of non-query graphics to accompany the data.

The Panhandle Regional 9-1-1 Network Mapping Department has been working to increase addressing accuracy in the Texas Panhandle. Since the last meeting, there have been over 900 changes, updates, or new features added to the sites/structures address point layer of the map. These changes have been added to the 9-1-1 workstations. In addition to the map corrections, we have been updating individual telephone numbers within the 9-1-1 Automated Location Information (ALI) database. Updating the database requires network staff to submit individual telephone requests to the telephone companies to update or correct their data. These updates should allow a landline call or text entry search to provide more precise location for the dispatchers.

The Panhandle Regional 9-1-1 Network has also transitioned to the GeoCOMM Data Hub 2 solution. This allows for more integrated dataflow between 9-1-1 provisioning authorities and more accurate uploads and quality control into the ESI-net.
